

CHAPTER 3

RUN-OFF ELECTION

3.01 RUN-OFF ELECTION METHOD ADOPTED. The run-off method of election provided for in Code of Iowa § 376.9, as amended, is hereby adopted in lieu of the primary election method of election provided for in Code of Iowa §§ 376.6 and 376.7.

3.02 RUN-OFF ELECTION REQUIRED. A run-off election shall be held for positions unfilled because of failure of a sufficient number of candidates to receive a majority vote in the regular city election.

3.03 RUN-OFF ELECTION CANDIDATES. When a run-off election is required, the candidates shall be those persons who do not receive a majority of the votes cast for the office for which they have filed but who receive the highest number of votes cast for that office in the regular city election to the extent of twice the number of unfilled positions.

3.04 CONDUCT OF RUN-OFF ELECTION. The run-off election shall be conducted at the time and place and in the manner provided for in Code of Iowa § 376.9, as amended.

3.05 CANDIDATES ELECTED. The candidates in the run-off election who receive the highest number of votes cast for the office for which they have filed shall be deemed to be elected to the extent necessary to fill the positions for which they have filed.
