Statistics

Significant Emergencies

December 1 – Residential Assignment – Urbandale

WHFD responded to a residential assignment in Urbandale. On arrival, WHFD crews served as the rapid intervention team (RIT), assisted with safety officer functions, and performed salvage and overhaul. All occupants of the residence escaped the fire without injury. No fire department personnel were injured, no fire department equipment damaged.
