ITEM TITLE: Public Hearing regarding the FY 2009 and FY 2010 Street Resurfacing Proposed Public Improvements

SUMMARY EXPLANATION

The Public Works Director recommends annually the streets, which need to be resurfaced in the community. There is a five-year plan for resurfacing streets and each year the Director inspects the streets to see if any should be added. The Public Works Committee discussed the streets planned for resurfacing in FY 10. They are:


- 70th Street from University Avenue to Colby Avenue, then east on Colby Ave from 70th for 65 ft;
- 64th Street from Lamar Street to dead end
- Mott Ave. from 65th Street to 64th Street.

The City opened bids on June 11, 2009. Grimes Asphalt was the low bidder. The bid was in the amount of \$127,048.76 for the 2009 calendar year street improvement project. The City Engineer's estimate was \$129,661.

The resurfacing program included in FY 09 were:

- 69th Street from Washington Avenue to 300 feet south of Hickman Road (2102 69th);
- Allison Ave from 64th Street to 66th Street
- 66th Street from Lincoln Ave to the dead end

The City opened bids on June 15, 2008. Des Moines Asphalt was the low bidder. The bid was in the amount of \$70,953.00 for the 2008 calendar year street improvement project. The City Engineer's estimate was \$71,575.00.
