Re: Public Works Report for the month of November

Significant Projects:

- All Sanitary Sewer inspections have been completed and documented.
- Storm Sewer Intakes have been inspected; Work list is documented for next spring.
- LED Stop Light 'Phased- In' bid process is in motion.
- Street Sweeping will be completed the last week/ 1st week in December.
- Annex was cleaned up after the Haunted House.
- Bike path painted across 73rd & University.
- A trash cleanup program is being established between W.H. & Sams / Walmart.
- Interviewing for Public Works Laborer Position.
- The flooding problem that has been an issue along the bike trail, by Wilshire Blvd, next to the bike trail has been resolved (see attached photo).
- The erosion problem at the end of Wilshire Blvd. has been resolved. Permeable Pavers set on 12" of recycled concrete were installed, **rather** than the use of 2 storm water intakes that would have put more water into Walnut Creek. Our existing planters from the park were reused to prevent driving on the pavers. (See Photo).
