

**ITEM TITLE:** Consideration of an ordinance to amend the 2006 Code of Ordinances by amending sections of Chapter 35: Solid Wastes and Yard Wastes.

**SUMMARY EXPLANATION**

Attached is an ordinance to adjust the rate for Curb It! service by \$.08 cents. Garbage and recycling are billed on Des Moines Water Works accounts. There is no garbage rate adjustment recommended this year as we were able to come to an arrangement with Artistic to provide the city an additional discount for the billing being switched to Des Moines Water Works. The Curb It! rate includes the amount we pay for Curb It! and an amount to offset billing costs, which brings the total to \$2.87.

ORDINANCE NO. 07-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2005 CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS, IOWA, BY AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 35: SOLID - YARD WASTES.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Windsor Heights, Polk County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend certain sections of Chapter 35 of the Municipal Code, to provide an adjustment in recycling rates to provide services to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Windsor Heights.

SECTION 2. Amended. Chapter 35.56, of Subchapter 5, Paragraph 1 is amended changing the following rates.

Monthly Recycling	<del>\$2.79</del>	\$2.87

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
