

**ITEM TITLE:** Consideration of an ordinance to amend the 2006 Code of Ordinances by amending sections of Chapter 25: Traffic Code

**SUMMARY EXPLANATION**

Attached is an ordinance to adjust the no parking zone back from 100 ft to 200 ft on 68<sup>th</sup> Street on the west side from the south boundary of Hickman road. Citizens have expressed concern about the number of cars parked in this area and its affect on traffic and safety at the intersection of 68<sup>th</sup> and Hickman. The Public Works Director evaluated the corner and recommended to the Public Works Committee the extension of the no parking area for an additional 100 feet. The Public Works Committee recommends approval of the ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 07-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2006 CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS, IOWA, BY AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 25: TRAFFIC CODE

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Windsor Heights, Polk County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend certain sections of Chapter 25 of the Municipal Code, to provide an adjustment in no parking zone to provide services to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Windsor Heights.

SECTION 2. Amended. Chapter 25.102 NO PARKING ZONES., is amended to read as follows:

78. Sixty-Eighth Street on the West side from the south boundary with Hickman Road to a point 200 feet south thereof.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
