Re: Police Department Monthly Report for July '10

Monthly Summary

The month of July began and ended with ceremonial dress for members of the Windsor Heights Police Department. We started off the month with the city's annual 4th of July celebration and parade. In spite of the rain, the parade went off without any measurable public safety issues. This year Chief Walters led the parade as a salute to his final special event before retiring. In all, the department had ten officers assist along the parade route in some capacity (four participated in the parade).

Another highlight of this year's parade was securing Metro STAR's armored vehicle to show off to our citizens. Officer Trace Kendig (WHPD) drove "the Bearcat". This is just one example of the equipment we have access to through partnering with other area agencies that participate in Metro STAR. The pooled resources we receive in this membership far exceeds what we would be able to muster individually as an agency. The members of this unit are specially trained in tactical encounters, dignitary protection, mitigation of high risk events such chemical, biological, radiological disasters and other homeland security related incidents.

The end of July marked the conclusion of Chief Walters forty year law enforcement career. On his last working day, Friday, July 30th the department held a retirement ceremony to honor Gary. The Chief was presented with gifts from the City, Police Association, and several certificates and plaques from area law enforcement bodies to honor his service to the Polk County area. Highlights of the formal procedure included the MacKenzie Highlanders bagpipers and full participation from the honor guard and police and fire personnel in a flag ceremony honoring Chief Walters. At the conclusion of the flag ceremony Gary was handed a portable radio to "go final" by radio for the last time in his career. The Polk County Dispatcher on the receiving end of the transmission gave a moving tribute across all radio channels saluting Gary's forty years of law enforcement service. No doubt Chief Walters will be missed by his staff and this community.

In between our special events this month, the police department kept busy. We had 641 calls for service of which 190 were traffic stops, we took 96 case reports, and made 41 arrests. Please see the attached statistical data for a complete breakdown of calls for service and reported crimes during the month of July and thus far in 2010. Annual statistics for 2009 and 2008 are posted for comparison. Personnel from the department also participated in their annual two hour legal in-service training update, and six officers completed their initial patrol rifle classroom certification.

I look forward to working more closely with you all in the months and years to come. –DM86
