**Significant Events**

**OK this May snowfall was not expected or needed! That was the 1<sup>st</sup> time in PW History we have ever had to put the snow equipment back on the trucks in May. I hope it is the last.**

**We have worked with Racom to install a temporary antenna system at PW for a few months until the new tower is operational at city hall.**

**Filling potholes is a nearly full time job these days. We put down 5 ton in one day last week!**

**WDM was contracted to test/certify our traffic light conflict monitors recently. This is part of an annual program I initiated to have a report available to document our maintenance items that were in need for our intersections. These include: Conflict Monitors, pedestrian signage/push panels, street markings, Pre-Emption System (Fire/PD), and some other items to be documented.**

**Our Parks are up and in fully operation. The sprinkler systems will be activated this year, with the new addition of rain....**

**We are scheduled to repair/replace 8 storm sewer intakes this summer. Our very worst intakes have been reconstructed (in-house), and we are now doing more spot reconstructions, rather than full reconstructions.**
