

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE HICKMAN ROAD WIDENING RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AS COMPLETE**

**WHEREAS**, on or about June 17, 2013, the City of Windsor Heights authorized the road reconstruction and widening on U.S. 6 (Hickman Road), in conjunction with a grant received from the Iowa Department of Transportation (the “Municipal Improvement”); and

**WHEREAS**, construction on said Municipal Improvements is now complete; and

**WHEREAS**, the completed total contract price is \$1,837,405.97, of which, the City received grants for 80% of the cost; and

**WHEREAS**, said Municipal Improvements have been reviewed by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, the Federal Highway Administration, and the City and found the same to have been completed in conformance with the contract documents and recommend acceptance of work completed; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Windsor Heights, Iowa that:

1. All of the Municipal Improvements required to be constructed pursuant to the project have been completed and are hereby accepted.
2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Polk County Recorder’s Office.
