# School directory

**C**owles Montessori School is dedicated to helping each child develop within his or herself the fundamental skills, habits, attitudes, appreciation, ideas and self-esteem which will be the foundation for a lifetime of creative learning. Our mission states: "Together we celebrate diversity, respect, and the love for learning through the Montessori Method. Our environment nurtures and prepares the child for a global community." Montessori education is based on the fundamental concept that a child learns best within a social environment which supports each individual's uniqueness. The Montessori child is free to learn because he or she has acquired "inner discipline" through exposure to the physical and mental order of the Montessori curriculum and environment. Habits of concentration, persistence and thoroughness, established in early childhood, produce a confident and competent learner in later years. Montessori education introduces children to the joy of learning at an early age and provides a framework in which intellectual and social discipline go hand in hand. In 1993 the Des Moines Public Schools started the first public Montessori program at Cowles with one preschool classroom. The program has expanded to serve preschool through eighth grade with 18 classrooms. All of the classrooms are multi-age and are directed by competent, dedicated professionals. Each faculty member is degreed and state certified at the bachelor's or master's level, as well as being certified by a recognized Montessori training program.

## City

- **City Council Meetings** are held the first and third Mondays of every month at 6 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 1133 66th St., unless posted otherwise.
- **Planning and Zoning Commission** meets every fourth Wednesday of the month at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 1133 66th St., unless posted otherwise.
- **Board of Adjustment** meets every third Tuesday of the month, as needed, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 1133 66th St., unless posted otherwise.

**The Planning and Building Department** assists the community with building or property development projects and handles inspections. If you are planning on starting on a project within the city, it is best to first contact the Planning and Building Department for permits that may be needed to comply with city code. The city issues permits for commercial and residential buildings, remodel projects, fences, signs, decks, driveway/sidewalk, plumbing and mechanical permits. The Planning and Building Department may also answer questions regarding history of a property for permits; you may contact us to investigate when a structure or dwelling was built and by whom. The Planning and Building Department works closely with the Planning and Zoning Commission and Board of Adjustment. The Planning and Zoning Commission oversees the administration of the Comprehensive Plan, zoning and long-range planning projects. The Board of Adjustment is a quasi-judicial board that hears appeals involving hardships resulting from strict application of the zoning ordinance. Under certain circumstances the Board may grant variances to code requirements. The Board also rules on a variety of other discretionary permits.

**Code Enforcement** is responsible for the enforcement of a variety of municipal ordinances which were created to promote the health, safety and welfare of our citizens. This important program enhances the quality of life in our city and helps to maintain healthy neighborhoods free of unsightly or hazardous conditions that can have a negative impact on surrounding property values. If you wish to register a code enforcement complaint, contact (515) 645-6826. Please be aware that the only way to ensure accurate follow up on Code Enforcement issues is to include your name and phone number when you submit the form. Code enforcement complaints can also be made online at [www.windsorheights.org](http://www.windsorheights.org). If your reported concern has the potential for police involvement or criminal charges, please contact the Windsor Heights Police Department at (515) 286-3632 to report your observations as they occur. The police department will also need your cooperation as an identified witness in court if you wish to pursue criminal charges.

**About Windsor Heights:** This is Windsor Heights — the city that is the heart of it all. Come, feel the heartbeat. The City of Windsor Heights is a unique community that was incorporated in 1941. dining opportunities, churches and elementary schools within and near the city limits and beautiful parks with improvements to come. Close by are centers of Polk County government, business and industry and outstanding educational institutions including Des Moines Area Community College, Grand View College, Drake University, Simpson College, Iowa State University, William Penn University and Upper Iowa University. Only minutes from downtown, Windsor Heights offers easy access to the Civic Center, other arts and entertainment attractions, the airport and expansive commercial opportunities.

**Community and Events Center:** After nearly six years in the planning, the Windsor Heights Community and Events Center opened in July of 2010. This signature facility can seat over 200 people and be split into two different sized rooms, depending on your special event needs. Since opening, the facility has hosted wedding receptions, birthday parties, corporate retreats/trainings and countless other events, including the First Lady of the United States, Michelle Obama. The center has received amazingly positive reviews from citizens and renters who have had the opportunity to experience the facility since it has opened. The Community and Events Center is located in Colby Park at 6900 School St. Colby Park also features a performance pavilion, tennis courts, a playground, open green space and a dog park just south of I-235 along the trail. The baseball field and performance pavilion are also available for rent and have been recently renovated.

**Trail System:** An enhanced trail system connects the park to other trails especially "The Missing Link" trail project as part of the Colby Trail that took years of planning to complete. The recently completed trail joins the Clive Greenbelt and Raccoon River Valley Trails to the west with the Walnut Creek Trail in Des Moines. The missing link trail runs from College Avenue to University Avenue along Walnut Creek and has greatly enhanced the recreational options in the community.

**Parks & Recreation: Colby Park** is located at 69th and School Street behind Wal-Mart. Colby Park is the signature Park for the City of Windsor Heights. The park is the location of the annual Fourth of July Celebration, band concerts and other community gatherings. The park includes a playground, trail, pavilion, tennis courts, ball field and Community Center. **Lions Park** is a smaller park that is located on property behind City Hall and adjacent to the Town Center III building at 65th and University. The gazebo that was formerly at Colby Park has been moved to Lions Park to enhance the usability as well as create a rain garden. The **Windsor Heights Dog Park** is open and ready for everyone to use with their favorite dog! The park is located south of Colby Park and I-235, adjacent to the trail and Budget Storage. For the best access, one should park at Colby Park, (6900 School St.) and walk on the trail south.

**Pet License:** Animals are required to be licensed in the City of Windsor Heights on an annual basis. Registrations are due between Jan. 1 and March 31 each year. After March 31, the penalty will double the registration amount. In order to obtain a license, a pet owner must present a current rabies vaccination certificate and proof of altering from your pet's Veterinarian. Annual Pet License cost is \$10 for altered pets and \$20 for unaltered pets. Should your pet become lost or you find a lost pet, please contact the Windsor Heights Police Department at 277-4453. Even if registered, pets are never permitted to run at large

in the city and must be on a leash or confined at all times. If a pet is at large, it will be impounded and the owner charged a fee. The impound fee and boarding fee charges are:

- \$75 for first impound
- \$100 for second and subsequent impounds
- \$20 per day boarding fee

Pet owners are required to pick up and dispose of all pet waste. Failure to comply with this ordinance is a misdemeanor.

**Garbage, Recycling and Yard Waste Collection FAQ:** Friday is your collection day in Windsor Heights for all services — garbage, yard waste and recycling. Garbage and yard waste (during the yard waste season) are collected EVERY week. Recycling is collected EVERY OTHER week (see calendar on lid for your week).

**GARBAGE - Who do I call?**

- For a missed collection? Call ASI, your garbage hauler, at 964-5229.
- For cart repair/replacement? Call ASI, your garbage hauler, at 964-5229.
- To start/stop service? Call Des Moines Water Works at 283-8700. Garbage service begins when water service is requested. If it's a new home, a cart will be delivered shortly after. Garbage service ends when water is canceled. When you move, leave your cart with the house.
- To request an extra cart (for a fee)? Call ASI, your garbage hauler, at 964-5229.

**RECYCLING - Who do I call?**

- For a missed collection? Call Waste Management, your recycling hauler, at 244-7336.
- For cart repairs/replacement? Call Waste Management, your recycling hauler, at 244-7336
- To start/stop service? Call Des Moines Water Works at 283-8700. Recycling service begins when water service is requested. If it's a new home, choose a 96- or 48-gallon cart at this time. The cart will be delivered shortly after. Recycling service ends when water is canceled. When you move, leave your cart with the house.
- To request a different size cart (96 and 48 gallon carts available)? Call Waste Management, your recycling hauler, at 244-7336.

**YARD WASTE - Who do I call?**

- For a missed collection? Call Waste Management, your yard waste hauler, at 244-7336.
- To sign up for the yard waste cart service? Visit Windsor Heights City Hall (1145 66th St., Suite 1) to fill out a form.

Residents can call Metro Waste Authority (244-0021) at any time for general questions about their service. For more detailed information residents can also visit the Windsor Heights page on the Metro Waste Authority website at [www.WhereItShouldGo.com/WH](http://www.WhereItShouldGo.com/WH).

**Location and easy access to interstate.** Windsor Heights has the unique distinction of being the only community that borders Des Moines, Urbandale, Clive and West Des Moines. # City

## City History

In what was once an area that had four operational underground coal mines, approximately 200 property owners in Walnut Township signed a petition that would lead to the official incorporation of the city of Windsor Heights on May 4, 1941.

Soon after, Don Mercer defeated E.A. McNabb for mayor and the five town councilmen elected were Fred Stroeber, A.M. Kephart, Henry Hughes, Fairus Troutman, and Elmer Torode. P.B. Harrison was elected treasurer, and H. Carman was elected assessor.

A feed station was purchased by the city and served as a town hall until the 1960s. The building stands to this day as a barely recognizable part of the store at 6507 University Ave.

In one of the first council meetings, Verne Akey was appointed Town Marshal. Mr. Akey occupied this position for many years on a part time basis and for an average salary of less than \$10 per month. In a law that remains in effect today, council erected a sign at the East and West city limits of University Avenue that read "Speed Limit 25 miles Per Hour - Road Patrolled."

During 1960 and 1961, the decision to locate the MacVickar in the southern part of Windsor Heights was made. Earlier possibilities were along University Avenue or even farther south along Ashworth Road.



By 1964 the construction of the freeway had progressed to what is now 73rd and Buffalo Road. The area just to the west of Buffalo Road was occupied by the Des Moines Golf and Country Club before relocating to West Des Moines. In all, 25 homes in Windsor Heights were sold to the highway commission and moved to make way for the project. Once complete in 1968, the MacVickar Freeway essentially connected Windsor Heights to the 41,000 miles of interstate highway that existed in the United States at that time.
