

CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES
June 1, 2015 - 6:00 p.m. City Hall - Publication Version

Mayor Willits called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Steve Peterson, Charlene Butz, Dave Burgess, and Betty Glover. Tony Timm was absent.

Approval of the Agenda

Councilmember Butz moved to approve the agenda; Councilmember Burgess seconded approval. Motion passed by voice vote unanimously.

Council Member Comments

Butz: Disappointed with percentage participation from Curb-It. A group of volunteers from Walnut Creek Church helped out with weeding the pavilion at Colby Park. They made a dent, but we need to get on top of it and have public works keep it up. **Glover:** No comment at this time. **Peterson:** No comment at this time. **Burgess:** No comment at this time.

Councilmember Peterson moved to approve the May 18, 2015, minutes; Councilmember Glover seconded approval. Motion passed by voice vote passed unanimously.

Councilmember Burgess moved to approve the issuing of the RFQ; Councilmember Glover seconded approval. Motion carried unanimously on a roll call vote.
