**A RESOLUTION APPROVING DEER HUNTING WITHIN
CITY LIMITS BY CONTRACTED CITY
BUILDING INSPECTOR – JASON VAN AUSDALL**

WHEREAS, the City of Windsor Heights desires to contribute to the control of the deer population within the City and metro area; and

WHEREAS, one method for controlling the deer population involves hunting during the legal hunting season by trained and approved members; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the safest environment possible, the City has adopted rules and regulations for hunting within City limits, which is only permissible by trained City employees; and

WHEREAS, former City employee, Jason Van Ausdall, remains employed with the City in a contracted capacity and is experienced in hunting within the City limits and working within the confines of the City hunting rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, written permission must be obtained from any property owners whose property is being utilized for the hunt, along with any property owners within 100 feet of the proposed deer stand; and

WHEREAS, Jason Van Ausdall has received written permission from resident Laura Belin (attached exhibit 1) to maintain an elevated stand and hunt from that location, and that deer stand is not within 100 feet of any other property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS, STATE OF IOWA, that contracted City Building Inspector, Jason Van Ausdall, is hereby approved to bow hunt within the City limits of Windsor Heights during legal bow hunting season in accord with the established rules and regulations, which are attached hereto (Exhibit 2).
