

Resolution No. 15-1167

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2020 SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FOR UNIVERSITY AVENUE MULTI-PURPOSE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS, IOWA

WHEREAS, the City of Windsor Heights is a full voting member of the Des Moines Area Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Surface Transportation Program provides funding to local jurisdictions for the construction of eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously approved a local match of \$160,000 for the Federal Fiscal Year 2019 Surface Transportation Program for said project on January 5, 2015; and

WHEREAS, additional project costs will bring the total to \$1,500,000, requiring an additional \$140,000 in local match. If awarded this round, the total federal match would amount to \$1,200,000, with a City match of \$300,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Windsor Heights, Iowa, that the City Council hereby supports the actions taken by staff in applying for funds through the Federal Surface Transportation Program, including the current request for additional funds.
