



Fire Marshal/Commercial Inspections

With assistance from the State Fire Marshal's Office, we will be obtaining a limited supply of free smoke detectors to hand out. This initiative is an attempt to raise awareness about fire prevention and the importance of smoke detector use. The WHFD will be making public announcement of this initiative once we receive the detectors. The department will be assisting residents with any questions or concerns they may have about fire prevention systems. We have also received 30 smoke detectors from KIDDE. KIDDE is a large manufacture of smoke detectors. KIDDE is also pushing awareness of smoke detectors in family occupancies. With the help of the State Fire Marshal's Office and KIDDE the WHFD can help educate and install smoke detectors in many of the occupancies in Windsor Heights that don't have the recommended number within the structure.

The Windsor Heights Fire Department's mission is to deliver excellent EMS and Fire service to the public through continuous training, rapid response, public education and fire prevention.

Community Outreach

The WHFD was out and about during Beggar's Night the evening of October 30th. The fire department was handing out glow sticks and interacting with families. The children loved the glow sticks and were able to get a quick tour of the fire trucks and take some pictures.



Fire Prevention Week

The week of October 5th - 9th crews were very busy with Fire Prevention Week. Everyday staff was either going to schools/daycares and giving a “show and tell” presentation while discussing fire safety with kids or giving tours in-house for groups who came by the station. The children and teachers were very happy and thankful for the opportunity to spend time with the firefighters.



Training Events

The WHFD conducted F.A.S.T. training in October. Crews were tasked with the challenge of fighting a second story house fire with difficult access. Crews were able to complete these evolutions by throwing ladders and attacking the fire from the outside or making entry elsewhere and stretching the hose to the fire room.



Recruit Academy

The recruit academy is in full swing. The recruits and instructors have been training every Monday and Thursday for four hours. The recruits have been learning the essential material and skills of the Firefighter I class. In November the recruits will get their first live fire experience and will be able to put what they've learned into action. In the picture below the recruits practiced pulling fire hose off the trucks. Recruits learned the methods of deploying to a structure, and then were tasked with stretching the hoses to an area and knocking over cones with the water stream. To date, only one recruit has dropped from the coursework due to an inability to commit to the necessary training and study requirements. The recruit class is on schedule to be completed in mid-December at which time the candidates will go through final skills assessments with a Fire Service Training Bureau proctor to become a certified firefighter.
