Consideration of Resolution No. 16-0101, A Resolution Naming Depositories for the City of Windsor Heights, Iowa Councilmember Peterson moved to approve the resolution, Councilmember Harms seconded the resolution. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Consideration of Resolution No. 16-0102, A Resolution Approving the Polk County Joint E911 Service Board Appointment of City of Windsor Representative and Alternate Councilmember Peterson moved to approve the resolution; Councilmember Glover seconded the resolution. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Consideration of Resolution No. 16-0103, A Resolution to Appoint a Member and Alternate Member(s) to the Polk County Emergency Management Commission Councilmember Harms moved to approve the resolution; Councilmember Peterson seconded resolution. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Consideration of Resolution No. 16-0104, A Resolution Establishing a Development Review Schedule for the 2016 Calendar Year Councilmember Peterson moved to approve the resolution; Councilmember Timm seconded the resolution. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Consideration of Resolution No. 16-0105, A Resolution to Declare Necessity and Establish an Urban Renewal Area, Pursuant to Section 403.4 of the Code of Iowa, Designating such Area as Appropriate for Urban Renewal Projects; and Adopting the Second Amended and Restated Urban Renewal Plan Councilmember Timm moved to approve the resolution; Councilmember Peterson seconded the resolution. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Consideration of Ordinance No. 16-01, An Ordinance Providing that General Property Taxes Levied and Collected Each Year on All Property Located Within the Second Amended and Restated Urban Renewal Area, in the City of Windsor Heights and Other Taxing Districts be Paid to a Special Fund for Costs Incurred by the City in Connection with the Second Amended and Restated Urban Renewal Area. (1st Reading) Councilmember Peterson moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance No.16-01; Councilmember Glover seconded the reading. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Consider Approval of Pay Application, Hickman/63rd Streetscape and Gateway Signage (Pay Application #2 / Final less Retainage) Budget Impact: \$90,137.20 Councilmember Peterson moved to approve the pay application #2; Councilmember Glover seconded the pay application. Motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.
