

Ordinance No. 16-02

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING A SCRIVENER'S NUMBERING ERROR IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Windsor Heights previously adopted Ordinance No. 15-02 on April 20, 2015, an Ordinance Adopting the Code of Ordinances of the City of Windsor Heights, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the City has been informed that a minor scrivener's error has been made in the numbering of Section 60.02—Traffic Control Devices; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it reasonable to amend to ordinance to correct such scrivener's error.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS, POLK COUNTY, IOWA:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to correct and amend a scrivener's error through the adoption and amending of the following renumbering of code sections.

SECTION 2. Amended. Section 60.03.01 is hereby amended as follows:

A. Move Section 60.02.07 (Automated Traffic Enforcement) to Section 60.02.08.

B. The amended numbering for Section 60.02 shall be as follows:

60.02.01 Installation of Traffic Control Devices

60.02.02 Compliance

60.02.03 Crosswalks

60.02.04 Traffic Lanes

60.02.05 Necessity of Signs

60.02.06 Standards

60.02.07 (Reserved)

60.02.08 Automated Traffic Enforcement

C. Only the numbering of such section shall be affected by this Ordinance. The content shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the

ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective after the final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
