

ORDINANCE NO. 17-04

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING A SCRIVENER'S ERROR IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR CHAPTER 101 (BILLING RATES FOR STORM WATER DRAINAGE) OF THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Windsor Heights previously amended Ordinance No. 12-09 on June 18, 2012, an Ordinance Amending Chapter 101 Storm water drainage utility; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2017, the storm water billing rates were amended via Resolution No. 17-0643; and

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2018, the storm water billing rates were amended via Resolution No. 18-0105; and

WHEREAS, this amendment does not change any billing rates for the City of Windsor Heights; and

WHEREAS, the City has discovered that the previously implemented storm water billing rates were not amended within the City's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 101; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it reasonable to amend the ordinance to correct such scrivener's error.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINDSOR HEIGHTS, POLK COUNTY, IOWA:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to correct and amend a scrivener's error through the adoption and amending of the rate categories in Section 101.03 of the Windsor Heights Code and the rate amounts in Section 101.04 of the Windsor Heights Code in accordance with previously adopted ordinances and resolutions.

SECTION 2. Amended. The rate categories in Section 101.03 and the rates in Section 101.04 are amended as set forth in Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective after the final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
