Overview

The construction of the sidewalks has been completed on all streets; 63rd Street, 64th Street and Del Matro Avenue. A punch list has been created by City staff and Bolton & Menk and delivered to the Contractor. A punch list is a list of items that do not conform to the contract specifications. The Contractor must complete these items prior to final acceptance of the project. The list includes seeding/reseeding, rock removal, backfilling and fixing defective items. These are just a few of the items on the list.

Project Timeline

The Contractor has started working on various items on the punch list the last few weeks in various locations. They have indicated they will continue working on the items during the month of September. All work is weather permitting.

Safety

It is very common on these types of projects that area residents (especially children) become quite curious about the work the Contractor is performing. We ask that you please be respectful of and stay well clear of construction zones. Many hazards and dangers exist from heavy machinery, trenches, loose material, confined spaces, etc. and often times are not recognizable by the general public. The Contractor has responsibility to ensure safety on the project and within the construction area. Any direction from the Contractor regarding safety must be heeded; likewise if you observe an unsafe condition please report it to Wyatt Klooster immediately.
